

Jesus Appears to Seven Disciples

21 After these things Jesus showed himself again to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias; and he showed himself in this way. 2 Gathered there together were Simon Peter, Thomas called the Twin,[a] Nathanael of Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. 3 Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We will go with you." They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing. 4 Just after daybreak, Jesus stood on the beach; but the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. 5 Jesus said to them, "Children, you have no fish, have you?" They answered him, "No." 6 He said to them, "Cast the net to the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast it, and now they were not able to haul it in because there were so many fish. 7 That disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" When Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord,

he put on some clothes, for he was naked, and jumped into the sea. **8**
But the other disciples came in the boat, dragging the net full of fish, for
they were not far from the land, only about a hundred yards[b] off. **9**
When they had gone ashore, they saw a charcoal fire there, with fish on
it, and bread.

The Eramosa Pastoral Charge Foodgrains project for 2022 is 2 plots of winter wheat. The starter fertilizer last fall was covered by donations. Thank you! Spring nitrogen fertilizer has been purchased for \$1800. Those individuals who can help to cover these costs would be greatly appreciated.

Update:

The spring application of nitrogen fertilizer was applied this past Monday. The wheat is green and growing. We would like to thank those that have contributed this year. So far we have received \$150 toward the \$1800 fertilizer bill.

We are also grateful for the \$850 that has been given for humanitarian needs in Ukraine. Others are encouraged to contribute to these causes as they are able.
